

Story worksheet: The party

Cut out, order and stick.



Unit 8 Story: Guidelines for parents and guardians

- Gina: Look! I like my dress and my shoes!
- Leo: Look! I like my hat and my trousers!
- Polly: Look! I like my trousers and my shoes!
- Mike: Look ... I like ...
- Gina, Polly
and Leo: Oh no! Don't worry. We can help.
- Leo: Wow!
- Gina: I like your trousers, your hat and your shoes!

Cut out the five pictures on worksheet part 1. Point to the characters. Your child says the names (encourage him/her to say trousers, dress, hat, shoes too). Ask what is happening in the story (the child tries to remember and explain in his/her own language). Read the story script and help the child put the pictures in the correct order. Check with Pupil's Book pages 68 and 69.

Give the child glue and the second part of the worksheet. He/She sticks the pictures down in order into the blank frames. When he/she has finished, talk about what is happening in the story again (Gina, Leo and Polly are ready to go to a fancy dress party and are talking about their clothes. Mike is sad because he doesn't have a costume. The other animals give Mike different items of clothing from their costumes to make an outfit.). The child can then colour the pictures.
