Caroline Nixon

Together, they have also written six titles in the Cambridge Copy Collection: *Primary Activity Box*, *Primary Vocabulary Box*, *Primary Grammar Box*, *Primary Pronunciation Box*, *Primary Communication Box* and *Primary Reading Box*. Caroline gives teacher-training talks and workshops internationally.

Since arriving in Spain, Mark has taught primary and secondary students as well as future university students on pre-sessional programmes. He has also run professional development training sessions and courses with teachers from across Spain and Portugal as well as delivering local and international webinars.
