B: *Trustworthy*. *Record* is a verb. What's the noun?
A: *Recording*. *Happy* is an adjective. What's the noun?
B: *Happiness*. *Die* is a verb. What's the adjective?
A: *Dead*. *Imagine* is a verb. What's the adjective?
B: *Imaginary*, or *imaginative*. But they mean slightly different things.
