		Assessment is about much more than testing students in order to give them a grade. When viewed more broadly, it can play an important role in the process of learning. In this talk, we'll explore the role of assessment in teaching and learning, including the principles and benefits of a 'learning-oriented assessment' (LOA) approach and how it can empower the teacher and the learner. We'll also look at ways in which teachers' informal, instinctive, and on-going evaluation of learners' progress can feed into the assessment process, including some practical examples of how the teacher can evaluate learners' progress effectively.
