## SPEAKERS

**ANDREA TOLVE** is currently Head of Teacher Training Iberia for Cambridge University Press and has been working in ELT since 1999, teaching in in Croatia and Spain. Andrea was a teacher and account manager at International House Madrid and followed this by becoming a Director of Studies at her own school. She has a Master of Arts in Education specialising in Applied Linguistics with the Open University.
