ED FIDOE is the co-founder of School 21, an innovative 4-18 school in London, designed for children from all starting points and backgrounds (achieved Outstanding Ofsted in 2014). School 21 has led the recent movement in oracy teaching in the UK and beyond, with the Voice 21 programme now working with hundreds of schools and training thousands of teachers. Recently Ed has moved to higher education and led the creation of a new university, The London Interdisciplinary School, which opened in September 2021.

Since moving to Spain in 2009 she has taught classes of all ages and levels, and delivered teacher training courses on a variety of topics and methodologies.
