

Emotion Poems Lesson Plans (Upper Primary)

- First, take an emotion to explore together with the class and use as an example for this activity. *Let's think about Love.* Ask the students what they think of when they think of love. It is likely that students may initially think of simple images like hearts and kisses. Tell the students that we are going to explore the emotion in more depth than this.
- Ask the students to close their eyes and think of love: *What does love look like? What colour is it? Who or what is it? Is it big or small?* Ask them to open their eyes and give them an example of your own first. E.g. *When I think of love, I see the house where I grew up, for me this represents love.* Now ask the students what they see and write some examples on the board. (Remember, there is no right or wrong answer for this activity, but we want to encourage the students to think about the emotions in a more abstract way).
- Ask the students to close their eyes again and think of love. *What does love smell like?* Again give some examples (e.g. hot chocolate, sweet perfume) and write examples on the board.
- Repeat for: *What does love taste / feel / sound like?*
- Now students can choose a new emotion and take time to think of the five questions for it. After the students have been given thinking time they can complete the worksheet and illustrate it too if they wish.
- Finally, ask each student / in groups to present their poems to the rest of the class. Explore the comparisons and differences between the ideas. We all think of these emotions in different ways, but we can understand each other!
