## SPEAKERS

**ANDREA TOLVE** is currently Head of Teacher Training Iberia for Cambridge University Press and has been working in the ELT world since 1999. She's taught in Croatia and Spain. Andrea was a teacher and account manager at International House Madrid and followed this by becoming a Director of Studies at her own school. She has a Master of Arts in Education specialising in Applied Linguistics with the Open University.

**MARK MEREDITH** began teaching English in Spain in 2010. He holds a Trinity DipTesor and is currently working as a Teacher Trainer for Cambridge University Press. Since arriving in Spain he has taught primary and secondary students, future university students on pre-sessional courses and has run a

variety of professional English courses for adults. Apart from this he also set up his own language tuition centre, taught in private academies and worked online as a coach for Rosetta Stone.

**TOM WOGAN** moved to Spain in 1993 and has remained here ever since. He is now a consultant for Cambridge Assessment English and is also a teacher at the EIM (Escola d'Idiomes Moderns) at the UB, where he specializes in exam preparation courses. Prior to working for Cambridge, Tom worked for a major publisher as a commercial representative and as a teacher trainer.
