Research demonstrates that when qualities such as curiosity, resilience, a growth mindset, perseverance and relationship skills are developed in pupils, there is an increase in motivation and they are more successful not just in school but in wider society. In this presentation, participants will be introduced to a model that brings these ideas together and can be incorporated into life and work of the classroom.

SPEAKERS
